


Carpathian Foundation-Hungary

The Carpathian Foundations have been established for the initiative of the *East-West Institute* and with the financial support of the *Charles Stewart Mott Foundation* with the aim to operate as a network of regional community foundations in the most underdeveloped bordering areas of the *Carpathian Euroregion* by supporting the citizens' and civic local development initiatives.



Strategic goal

To improve the **human** resources (people, organizations, communities) of the region for the development of marginalized communities, minorities and territories, thus indirectly contributing to the reduction of poverty and social exclusion.





Activities

The **Foundation** engages in both **grant-making** and **programmatic activities**, and since the beginning it has granted totally **15 million USD** to hundreds of NGOs and LSGs.

Currently the Foundation runs its programs to fulfill the following main objectives:

- to support local development initiatives of NGOs and communities;

- to raise social awareness and to support disadvantaged youth.


